

PSYC 349: Human Behavior in Organizations

Blends together research and insights from 3 fields: personality psychology, positive psychology, and human relations. Students will: (1) gain a deeper understanding of human behavior in general, (2) learn about their own personality by taking the Big Five assessment, (3) assess their current level of emotional intelligence through the EQ-i 2.0 assessment, and (4) learn practical actions to further develop their personal and professional relationships.
