

MILS 325: Advanced Military Science Practicum

Four-week course conducted at Fort Lewis, WA. Topics include instruction, training, and evaluation focus on the professional development required to become an Army Officer. The focus of this training is to evaluate the student's leadership potential through a mentally and physically demanding camp. Training and evaluation conducted 7 days/week for 5 weeks. Requires active participation by all students. A student placed in leadership positions which require him/her to lead up to 120 fellow students for extended periods of time. This course is a Prerequisite for receiving a commission in the US Army through ROTC and for MILS 411 and 412.
